

ABOUT THE EVENT

The Sky's No Limit annual events are the cornerstone of outreach initiatives founded by B.C. pilot, Kirsten Brazier. What began as a small Aviation event in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories in 2012 has evolved into the world's largest Aviation, Aerospace, Marine and Defence outreach event. The event has been proudly hosted by the Abbotsford International Airport in Abbotsford, British Columbia, Canada since 2015.

DID YOU KNOW? Since 2012 we've made a life-changing impact for over 160,000 women and girls of all ages, and we've made it possible for 14,484 women & girls to experience the magic of first flight in a helicopter - FREE!

Our events, including the introductory flights, are always free to ensure there are no barriers to participation. To achieve this, we rely on the financial, but also considerable in-kind support from many agency, industry, education and community partners working together to inspire future generations.

Why is this event so important? In both Canada and the United States, only 6% of the professional pilot population are women - a statistic largely unchanged in the last 30 years. In Canada, only 2.3% of licensed Aircraft Maintenance Engineers are women. In the Canadian Armed Forces, women account for only 4% of the technical trades and less than 3% of the top command positions. **Worldwide, women account for only 1.28% of the global seafarer force.** Additionally, there is a widespread shortage of skilled labour in general across many industries. All the more reason to engage a previously untapped demographic to help fill the gaps!

From the numbers it might be tempting to conclude that women are either uninterested or unwelcome in these fields. Instead, studies have shown that a common perception persists that high technology fields are reserved for men. From an early age, everyone is affected by this ingrained message, which is continually reinforced by observation in our daily lives (lack of change), media, social media and advertising. The low numbers also mean that most women have no direct family, peer and/or networking connections in high-tech fields, therefore it is unreasonable to expect gender and cultural diversity to resolve naturally in these areas.

The Sky's No Limit free outreach events and other initiatives aim to change this perception and awaken new interests by providing women and girls of all ages with fun, interactive, and hands-on introductions into high-tech fields.

You can expect people of all ages at our events - our approach is inclusive of all generations for best results! Here's why:

- **Recruit for tomorrow plant the seed early for future change:** Inspire youth early so they're aware of the endless future career and/or volunteer possibilities for themselves and others.
- **Recruit for today:** Target recruit-ready adults including those considering a career change and introduce them to incredible new opportunities they likely didn't know were open to themselves or others in their network.
- **Educate the mentors:** Parents, counsellors and other mentors will be better equipped to advise the women & girls they counsel having personally experienced these "non-traditional" opportunities themselves.
- Engage the wisdom and influence of elders: Elders are encouraged to participate for an experience of a lifetime! Elders generally have the greatest circle of networking and influence, plus in many cultures it's the elders that others turn to for wisdom and guidance. Their inclusion and support can have a very powerful effect towards change, particularly where traditional norms are concerned.

FREE Flights for Women & Girls (any age)

Our signature annual events honour past, present and future female leaders from shop floor to top floor in Aviation, Aerospace, Marine & Defence. Despite the incredible opportunities available in these high-tech fields, women remain conspicuously absent. Our events employ a unique, hands-on approach to pique the interest of our target audience, create a network of experience and raise awareness of new possibilities.

To attract more women and girls to the airport and get them excited to explore the event, we offer free introductory flights for hundreds of female first-time fliers. It is thanks to the generous support of industry and community partners that we are able to provide this precious gift to participants.

There is no minimum or maximum age, and we encourage female friends and/or family to enjoy the flight together. The first flight experience is incredible beyond words and when the fliers land they are intrigued to learn more!

The free flights are reserved for girls and women of any age, who haven't flown in a small aircraft before. Government-issued identification and signed guardian consent/waiver are required. Aircraft, Vehicles, Equipment & Displays

Open to everyone.

An incredible variety of civilian and non-civilian vessels, vehicles, activities, hands-on equipment and displays are available to explore. Exhibitors will be on hand with their assets to answer participant questions and facilitate exploration between 09:00 to 17:30 each day.

All participants are encouraged to engage in this unique opportunity for an inside look into the various aspects of Aviation, Aerospace, Marine and Defence. There will be plenty of photo and video opportunities so bring your camera and take those selfies!















TREASURE MAP GRAND PRIZE DRAW

Open to everyone.

To help guide participants through the event and excite them to explore all the displays, we encourage everyone to complete the treasure map for a chance to win a grand prize. Platinum, Gold, Silver and agency partners are featured as key destinations on the map. Participants must locate and engage with each exhibitor to earn credit for having visited. Partners featured on the treasure map have some discretion over what participants must do to earn this credit, e.g., answer three questions about their display/activity, play a game, find a hidden clue, etc.

Treasure maps are included within the official event program and made available to all participants at key locations throughout the venue. Display partners are encouraged to help distribute the event program and promote the treasure map. In order to be eligible for the grand prize draw, participants (any age, any gender) must present the completed treasure map at the designated Treasure Map station and fill out a ballot. Only one entry per participant is permitted. Once the map has been used for entry in the draw, the map is marked accordingly and returned to the participant as a keepsake.







TREASURE MAP AS A PASSPORT

Passports may only be used for the free flights by an eligible female first-time flier.

For women and girls that are excited to experience the magic of first flight in a helicopter, their first step upon arrival should be to obtain a printed copy of our FREE event program which contains the treasure map described on the preceding page. Aside from the treasure map grand prize contest which is open to everyone, the treasure map may also be used as a passport to obtain free flights for eligible female first-time fliers.

Aside from select early morning flights awarded as part of our **Social it Forward** challenges to help spread the word in advance of the event, the free flights for female first-time fliers (any age) may only be earned via **Treasure Map as a Passport.** Each eligible female first-time flier desiring to fly must present a fully completed map at the designated flight registration station before they may proceed with flight registration. While everyone is welcome to complete the map, only an eligible female first-time flier may use it to access the free flights.

A fully completed map unlocks access to the free flights for each eligible female first-time flier. Flights are available on a first-come, first-serve basis, weather permitting and as we have available capacity. Once the map has been used for flight, the map is marked accordingly and returned to the participant as a keepsake.

NOTES: While anyone is welcome to qualify for **Treasure Map as a Passport**, the map may be used only once to provide entry for a single eligible female first-time flier. Eligible female first-time fliers wishing to fly together must each present a qualifying **Treasure Map as a Passport**. Government-issued photo identification (ID) and a signed guardian consent/waiver are required in order to fly (some alternate forms of ID may be considered for students and infants). Consent/waiver forms are available for download on our website, and may be signed in advance where the legal guardian will not be present at the event. She is Anything!

The She is Anything! mission began as an annual event in 2012, and later evolved into a federally incorporated non-profit organization running year-round events, projects and programs. We inspire female future leaders from shop floor to top floor in high-tech fields with incredible, FREE, hands-on experience events. We are entirely unique in our approach and completely volunteer driven. Our offerings are always completely free to participants to prevent barriers to participation.

We presently operate 3 distinct initiatives:

- **The Sky's No Limit** World's largest Aviation, Aerospace, Marine and Defence outreach event. This is our signature annual event, where absolutely everyone is welcome no registration required.
- Operation: This IS You! These are year-round hands-on experience events for women & girls held in the native environments of our agency and industry partners. These incredible, action-based events have a STEM focus and smaller group sizes to maximize the hands-on impact. To participate, there is an application process, varying lower age-limits for liability reasons (generally no upper age limit), and entry into these events is by invitation-only.
- **Project STEM Girl** This is a revolutionary, Top Secret term project currently under development and being held in reserve for the right circumstances to launch. It is infinitely scalable to reach varying age groups and geographically diverse audiences. It is the first of its kind in the world!

Our goal is to ensure that all our event participants and volunteers are diverse in age, culture and socio-economic background, which is why we're continually growing our broad network of community, education, Indigenous and cultural organizations and groups. We hope you'll help us spread the word far and wide!

Our under-funded non-profit Foundation is entirely run by volunteers, so we encourage you to share these details with any network connections and/or staff that might like to help us out.
